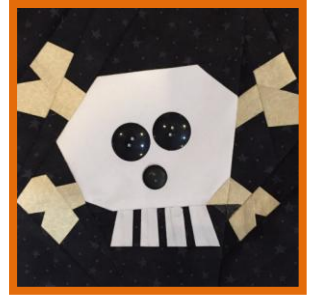


Black and White Halloween Collection of Blocks



Finished size: 7½" x 7½"

Materials:

Assorted scraps for paper piecing.

Fat eighth (9" x 22") of background fabric.

Black embroidery floss.

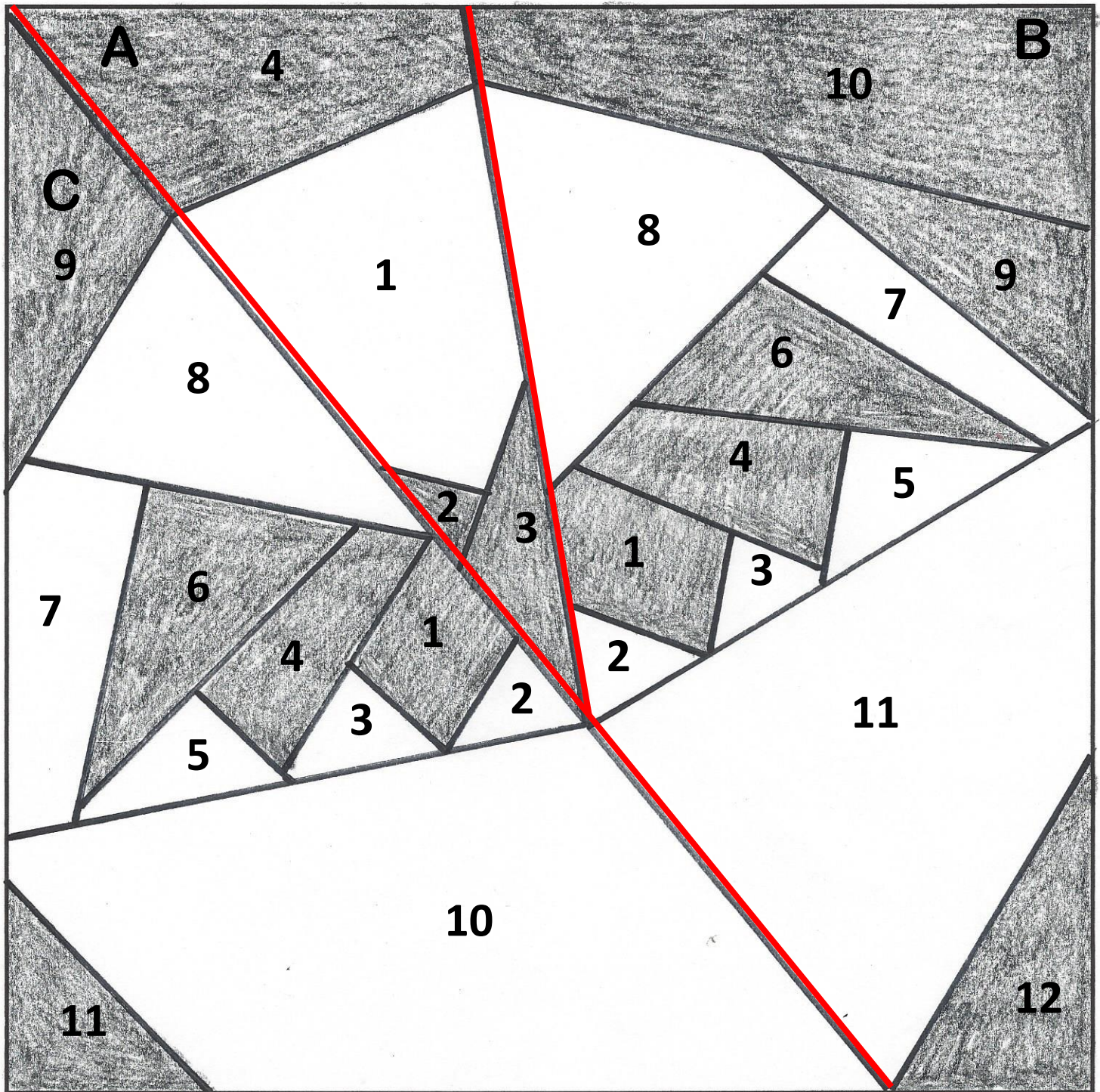
Assorted buttons.



Directions:

1. Make the appropriate number of copies of the original pattern.
2. Cut around the segments, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
The red lines show the edges of each segments. (See photos on pattern sheet.)
3. Paper piece each segment. Visit my website: madebymarney.com to see a tutorial on *How to Paper Piece a Simple Block* and *How to Paper Piece a Combination Block ,Parts 1 and 2*. While you are there, please **subscribe**.
4. Connect the segments in the designated order.
5. Trim the blocks to 8" x 8", unfinished.
6. Hand stitch any details with black embroidery floss using a straight stitch.
7. Hand sew the required buttons where indicated.

Bat By Moonlight



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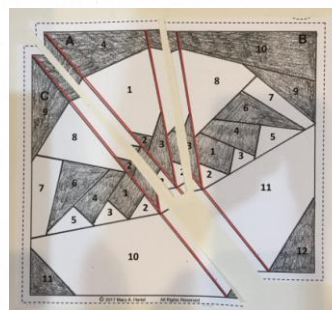
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Make 3 copies of the original pattern and cut around the segments, adding $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams (see photo).

Paper piece each segment.

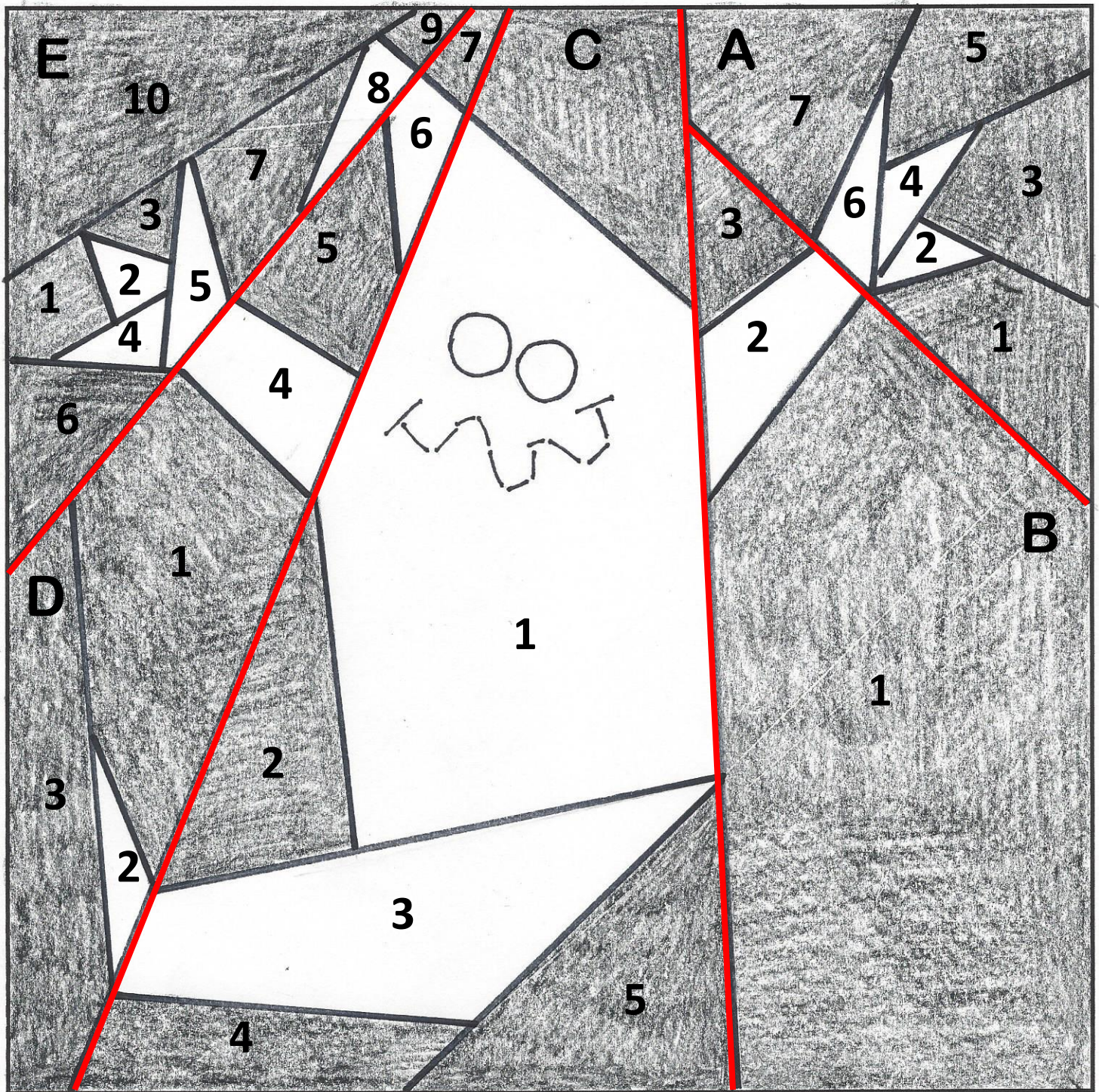
Connect segments in this order: **A to B**, **A/B to C**.

Trim block to 8"x 8".



Ghosty

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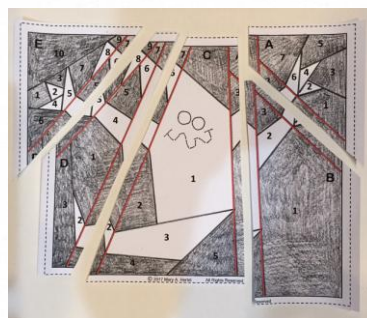
Make 3 copies of the original pattern and cut around the segments, adding $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams (see photo).

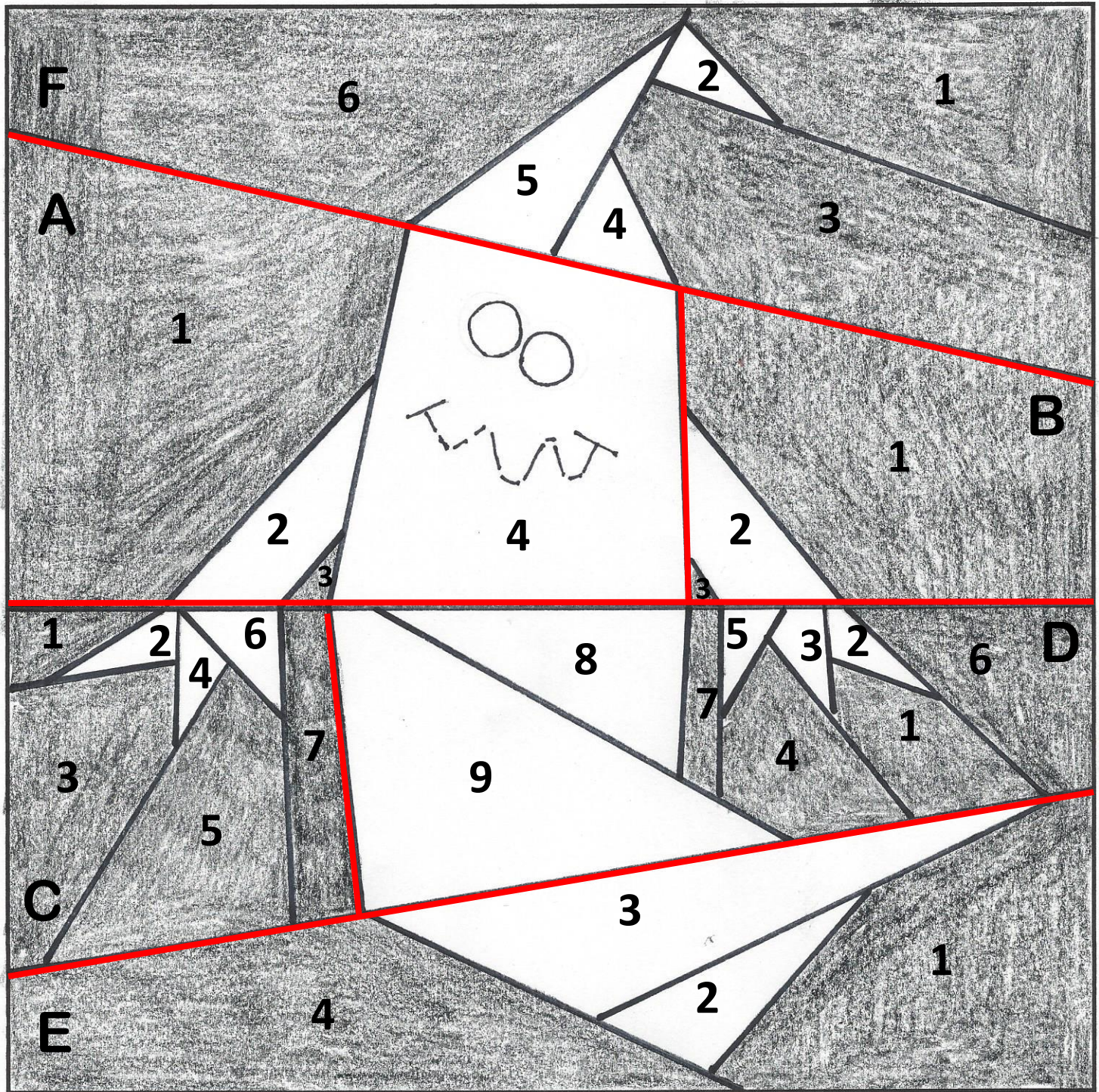
Paper piece each segment.

Connect segments in this order: **A to B,**

A/B to C to D to E. Trim block to 8"x 8".

Hand sew 2 black $\frac{1}{4}$ " buttons for the eyes. Hand stitch the mouth with black embroidery floss.





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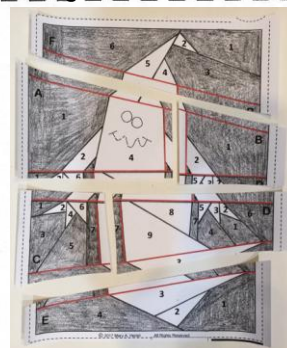
Make 3 copies of the original pattern and cut around the segments, adding 1/4" seams (see photo).

Paper piece each segment.

Connect segments in this order: **A to B, C to D.**

A/B to C/D, A/B/C/D to E to F.

Trim block to 8"x 8". Hand sew 2 black 1/4" buttons for the eyes. Hand stitch the mouth with black embroidery floss.

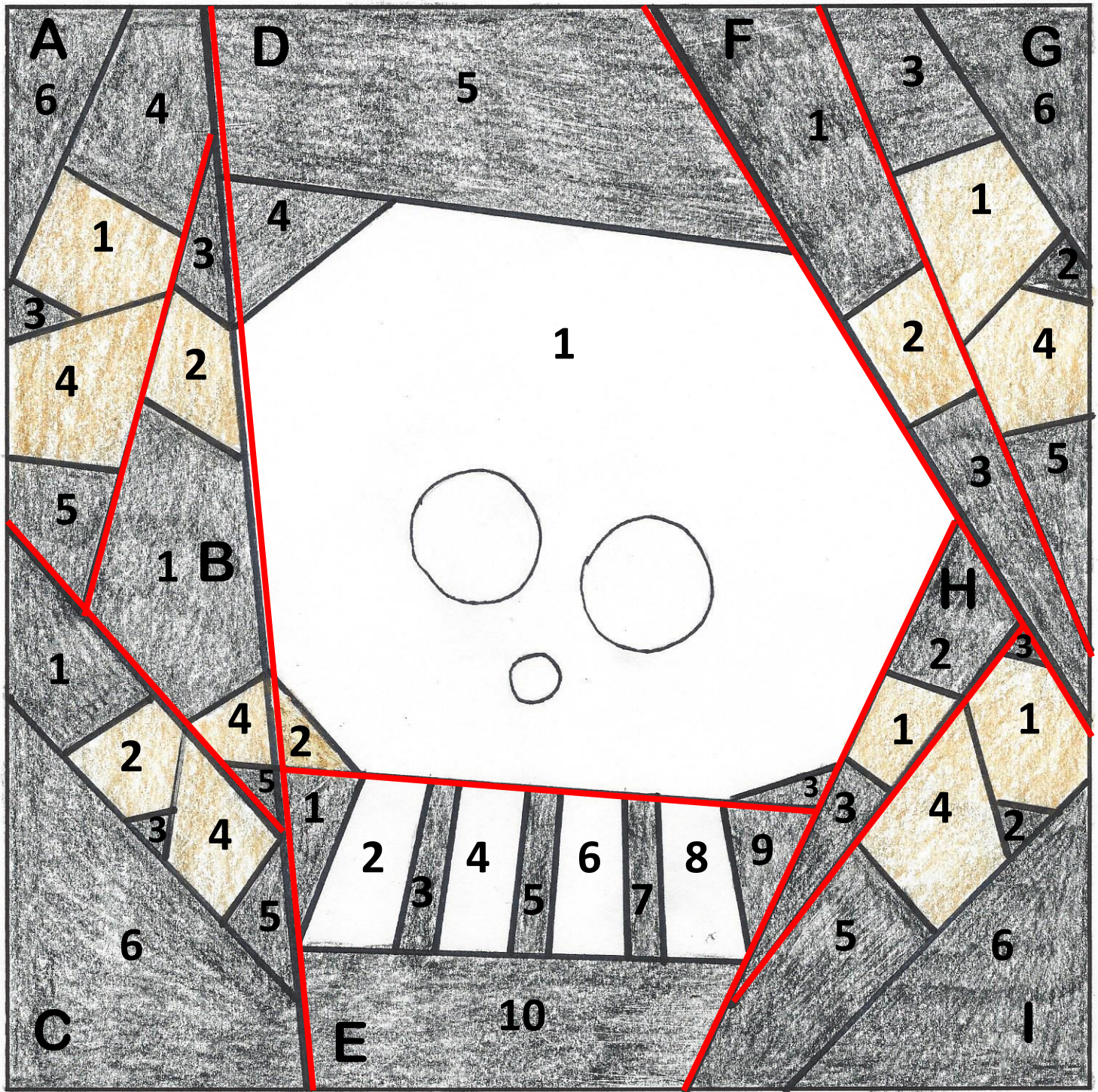


Skulky Skull

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Make 5 copies of the original pattern and cut around the segments, adding $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams (see photo).

Paper piece each segment.

Connect segments in this order: **A to B to C, D to E, F to G, H to I, A/B/C to D/E to H/I to F/G.**

Trim block to 8"x 8". Hand sew 2 black 1" buttons for the eyes and 1 black $\frac{1}{2}$ " button for the nose.
